SENIOR GOLF



MEN'S GOLF LEAGUE



As the days start to shorten, we have made decisions about ending the season and this is to communicate them.

- 1 There will not be a closing banquet as it is not possible to plan one with certainty for a league with 76 members and health concerns still affecting us.
- 2 Each league player will receive a CC of W golf shirt. They can pick from several choices of design, size, and color. They will need to visit the golf shop to make their selection and then the item can be ordered. Players should do this soon in order to make the process go smoothly.
- We plan to end Thursday league play on August 27 and Tuesday league play on September 22.
- A Ryder Cup style event will be held on Thursday, September 10 with September 17 as a rain date. Tuesday players and Thursday players will play 9-hole matches head to head or in a twosome against players of comparable handicaps so most, if not all, matches are played without strokes. Those who sign up will be divided into two teams to equalize handicaps. There will be a 4:15 shotgun start because sunset is earlier.
